Wolves are the largest member of the Canid family and are very common throughout the Northern hemisphere.

The most common type of wolf is the timber wolf.

They can weigh as much as 175 pounds.

Wolves hunt, travel and live in groups called packs. Each pack has a head wolf called the Alpha male. These packs can roam up to 12 miles a day.

Nocturnal, they hunt at night and sleep during the day.

Wolves are meat eaters and like large meals of up to 20 pounds.

Wolves are considered a species at risk.

Q: What do wolves have that no other animal has?

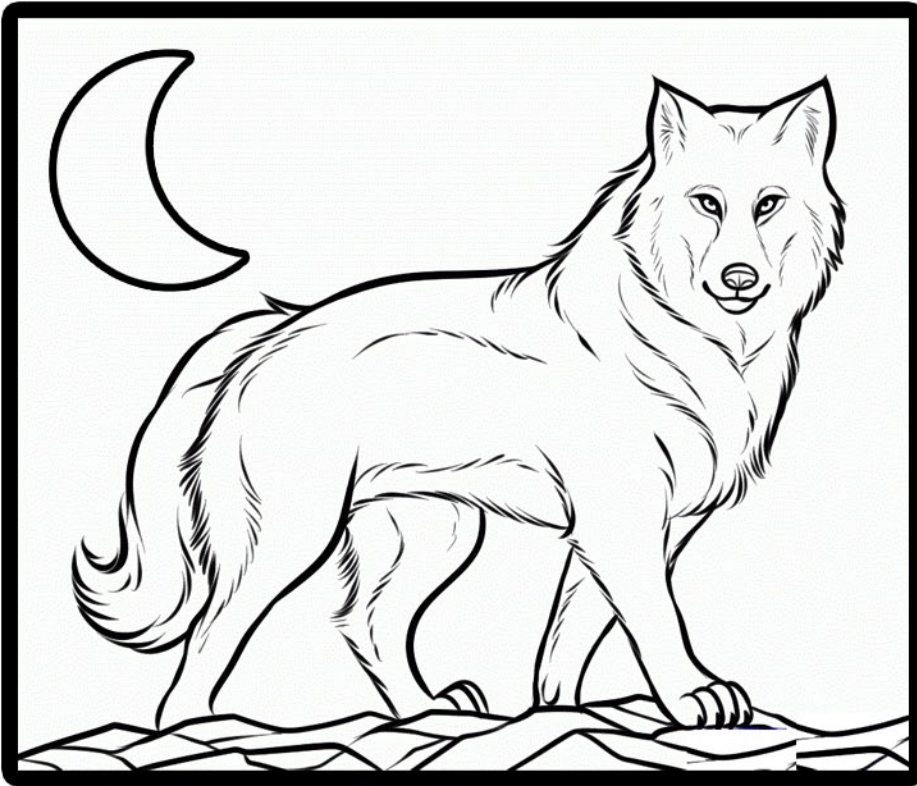
A: Wolf cubs!
